

# Hearing Notice for Danville Residents

## Danville Zoning Bylaw Amendment

### Selectboard Proposal

#### Thursday, March 19, 2026, 6:00 p.m.

The Danville Selectboard, in accordance with 24 V.S.A. § 4444, will hold a hearing on proposed amendments to the Zoning Bylaw on **Thursday, March 19, 2026, beginning at 6:00 p.m.** in the Danville Town Hall. All Danville community members are invited to attend, either in person or remotely, to review the proposed amendments, which updates several sections of the zoning bylaws.

The Zoning Bylaw provides for orderly community growth, encourages appropriate development in accordance with 24 V.S.A. § 4302, and implements the intent of the Danville Town Plan. The proposed amendments make required changes throughout to ensure compliance with FEMA standards to meet the requirements for the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) and offer clarification for subdivision guidance and Certificate of Occupancy to aid residents and the Zoning Administrator.
