4. Treasurer business: \$10,000 of our \$17,250 Conservation Fund has been invested in a CD. We have \$1000 annual operating budget. Discussion on Northwoods plans, and best date for a meeting with Dusty. Official vote to use \$5000 of funds this year for trail building/maintenance with Northwoods. Discuss schedule.

7. Arbor Day, Green Up Day, No Mow May, coordinating VT Invasives or Intervale or Emily Meacham to meet with the Danville Highway crew to give them an education on invasives? Hands on, identification in the field on the roadways, as well as provide with tools for cleaning mowing equipment. Provide mowing schedule and techniques that they can teach residents who ask them what to do. Answer any questions they have and provide support for them.
