





TOWN OF DANVILLE STUMP DUMP POLICY

- 1) The Stump Dump will accept only yard waste such as leaves, grass clippings, plant materials, etc., and untreated wood waste for passive composting.
- 2) By law, no treated, painted or stained wood can be accepted. Also, no construction materials such as sheetrock, concrete, brick, rock, metal, etc., will be accepted.
- 3) Two areas will be designated at the Stump Dump:
 - a. For yard waste and untreated wood waste
 - b. Rock, dirt, highway construction debris generated from Danville Highway Department
- 4) The Stump Dump will be opened with volunteer attendants on the first and third Saturday of the months of May through October from 8:00 AM to 12:00 Noon.
- 5) If the town is unable to secure sufficient volunteers to support this schedule, the town may need to hire an attendant or adjust the hours of operation.
- 6) Each volunteer will receive a brief training regarding what is and is not acceptable material.
- 7) The attendant will maintain a log of materials received that includes:
 - a. Date
 - b. Name
 - c. Address
 - d. Type of material
 - e. Approximate weight of material
 - f. Name of attendant
- 8) Materials will be accepted by Danville residents only or contractors working on Danville property.
- 9) If it is not possible for a town resident or contractor working on Danville property to utilize the scheduled Saturdays, a person may request a scheduled appointment. A volunteer will arrange a mutually agreed upon time for acceptance of the material through the Selectboard office.
