- 1. Approved April minutes.

- 4. Discussed Green up Day and our personal contributions including being over-consumers.
- 5. Dawn and Jo discovered Gout weed at Rogers Lot. Dawn volunteered to post the invasive challenge link by iNaturalist on FPF and send the links to Vange and Bridget so we can post on the Facebook page and send to Audrey. Vange suggested using the Rogers lot as an educational tool for invasives. The "Valley of Invasives". Since its impossible to eradicate the invasives in the town forest, we may as well highlight it and use it to educate.
