Plainfield Slope Stabilization Project!

The Vermont Agency of Transportation (VTrans) has completed work on the Plainfield Emergency Slope Stabilization Project on U.S. Route 2 (U.S. 2) approximately 0.2 mile west of the intersection with Vermont Route 214 (VT 214) in Plainfield. The project began in September 2024 and work primarily consisted of sheet pile installation and drilling grouted soil nails to stabilize the failed slope. The project included a two-week (14 day) closure of a portion of U.S. 2 from Monday, September 16 to Monday, September 30, to allow crews to complete the work.

VTrans is now seeking your feedback on the construction and communication throughout the project. The survey should take no more than 5 minutes to complete and will provide valuable insight to the project team. The survey will remain open until Wednesday, November 13, 2024.
