Construction Update Marshfield-Danville NH PS19(1) [U.S. Route 2 Resurfacing Project]

DATE: Friday, October 25, 2024

TRAFFIC IMPACT AND DURATION: Monday, October 28, through Friday, November 1, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., motorists can expect lane closures with alternating one-way traffic patterns and minor delays on U.S. Route 2 (U.S. 2) from the intersection with Vermont Route 232 (VT 232) in Marshfield and continuing east to the intersection with Vermont Route 15 (VT 15) in West Danville. Flaggers and Uniform Traffic Officers will be present to assist motorists through the work zone.

Motorists are encouraged to use caution while traveling through the work zone and plan for minor delays.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES: From Monday, October 28, through Friday, November 1, crews will be paving side roads near the Marshfield Dam and Danville Hill Road. Crews will also be placing aggregate shoulders to back up the newly placed pavement near the Marshfield Dam and Danville Hill Road. On Thursday, October 31, crews will start guardrail work near Joe's Pond in West Danville.
