- Carpet: is down and looks great, a couple of fixes on a portion of the floor that was rotten
 underneath and some work on the binding on the carpet in the Community Room. Liz will contact
 Craig regarding the kitchen floor.
- Memory Tree: Saturday, December 7, 7pm; Mary read the list of deceased folks since last October. With the names read, five stood out as having been very community minded and a help to the North Danville Community Club and building:

We decided to definitely go with these five people. MOTION: made, seconded, and passed to honor them.

Also, we had a discussion about the format of the Memory Tree Service with ideas about changing the order, having the lighting at the end as it is the highlight of the event, reading the names once and not going into who gave. Perhaps a carol or two sung after the welcome at the tree lighting (with the names read before or after the lighting) finishing with a prayer and Silent Night, and proceed to the church dining room for refreshments and fellowship. One reason being people show up for the lighting and then we lose most of them as they do not come into the sanctuary for the reading which has become quite lengthy. - There has been a request for a student to do a Senior Project for the building/grounds. Lee will find out more information and get back to us.

- Lee will ask the town if we can "hire" Ryan Heath for small jobs that need to be done instead of going to a selectboard meeting all the time. Big projects, of course, would go through the selectboard.
- There is a possible grant for a pellet boiler, which is being looked into, and a neighbor on Cormier Road has offered a site visit to see his and how it works.
